ANTI-CORRUPTION POLICY



PUSTAKA is committed to comply with all regulatory conditions and anticorruption standards requirements by:

- 1. Creating a corruption-free environment and achieving the six shared values of the Sarawak Government;
- 2. Complying with relevant Laws, Regulations and this Anti-Corruption Policy against bribery and corrupt practices;
- 3. Upholding anti-corruption principles in all business dealings and interactions with external parties, including business associates, government agencies and stakeholders;
- 4. Establishing Anti-Corruption organisational plan and continuously monitoring and improving its implementation;
- 5. Providing avenues for employees and external parties to report any suspicious corruption activities by providing suitable channels of communication and ensuring information is treated appropriately;
- 6. Upholding the values of transparency and governance within Pustaka;
- 7. Establishing an independent function to be responsible for anti-corruption compliance within Pustaka;
- 8. Subjecting Pustaka's personnel who do not comply with this Anti-Corruption Policy to the appropriate disciplinary measures and the relevant laws and regulations;
- 9. Conforming to the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2009 (MACC Act 694).
